The Apostolic Succession of the Anglican Church was through the Roman Church from the arrival of St. Augustine in A.D. 597 until the Act of Supremacy in A.D. 1534 when King Henry VIII asserted control over the English Church; Thomas Cranmer was, at one time, Archbishop of Canterbury and Primus of all England.
